

CLASS POLICIES (GENERAL) – DECEMBER 2021

INTERNET AND SOCIAL MEDIA

At shows, competitions and similar public events, photographs may be taken and published on the East Sussex Dance website and social media pages. Photographs and videos will always be chosen responsibly and will never include a child's name, with the exception of outstanding individual achievements where the parent is happy for their child to be named.

CLASS FEES

As stated on the fees document, class fees are due during the first week of each half term via BACS to East Sussex Dance or cash in a named envelope – we do not accept cheques. The fees document which includes payment deadline dates and prices for all classes is regularly updated and can always be found online at www.eastsussexdance.com/fees.pdf. Late fees incur a £10 administration charge which should be paid with the late fees.

In the case of government imposed lockdown, any prepaid classes will automatically move across to Zoom.

If for any reason a student is unable to continue with their class, **four weeks written notice or the equivalent in fees is required.**

CLASS CANCELLATION

When a teacher is unwell, we will always endeavour to find another teacher to cover the class. Where this is not possible, credit will be carried across to the following term and the fees document will be updated accordingly.

Where adverse weather conditions result in class cancellation, sadly we cannot offer a refund but where suitable we may offer students an alternative class to attend.

Updated Conditions of Attendance

Introduction

These guidelines are subject to change according to government advice, as well as the advice of the dance organisations we are members of. We will keep you informed as to any changes should they occur.

By attending you agree to submit to our COVID agreement –

Students with COVID-19 symptoms should not attend

Students agree to notify East Sussex Dance should they have a positive test result following a class

Students agree to East Sussex Dance holding contact details for the purpose of Test and Trace

Please wash / sanitise hands on arrival and continue to follow “common sense” hygiene (cough into elbow, “catch it bin it kill it” etc.)

We encourage all students to test regularly, especially if taking part in a partner-dancing class.

It is not recommended to wear a mask whilst exercising.

Distancing vs Capacity

I will no longer be enforcing social distancing in lessons however we will continue to have a “limited capacity” approach. The capacity at each of our venues is regularly reviewed, taking into account the size of the room, height of the ceiling and quality of ventilation.

Partner Work / Pairs

In classes where we are learning partner work, students will have one or two fixed partners in a class. We are not encouraging multiple “partner swapping” at this point.

Physical Corrections

By attending, you accept that occasional contact between teacher and student is necessary for the purpose of learning correct placement and positioning, particularly where visual/verbal correction is insufficient. Teachers will ask permission before coming into a pupil’s space, and any corrections will be brief and precise.
